All applicants SHALL supply documentation confirming eligibility, including but not limited to:

- Proof that applicant is currently a Junior or Senior in High School¹ or currently enrolled in an accredited higher education establishment.
- Proof that parent² served³ in:
 - A. Military service of parent including branch, rank, dates of service (E-4 to O6 eligible)
 - B. Law Enforcement Organization of parent, rank, dates of employment
 - C. Emergency Responder Unit, rank, and dates of employment
- The applicant's parent had to have passed while on active duty or while actively employed. Proof of employment at time of loss⁴.
- Proof of Kinship⁵
- Proof of Loss⁶

Video Essay Question

Video Essay Question – The video essay questions need to be provided through a YouTube link for each answer. Once submitted, the videos become the property of the Battlefield Commander Foundation and may be used for marketing and promotional purposes (with the exception of question #3 – Parent Video).

- **Who are you?**
 - A. Applicant's full legal name, permanent residence, address at school, mobile telephone #, email address, current social media handles, date of birth, citizen status (90 seconds).
- **What do you do?**
 - A. Discuss academic accomplishments. Begin with grades, grade point average, SAT/ACT scores. Discuss stronger classes and why you were stronger in them and weaker classes and why you were weaker in them. You are encouraged to discuss one academic "do over" (90 seconds).
 - B. Discuss extra-curricular activities. Topics to discuss include but are not limited to, 1. Sports, 2. Clubs, 3. Travel Teams, 4. Employment. You are encouraged to discuss sports and activities that you have thus far excelled in as well as areas that now in retrospect, you could have concentrated on more (90 seconds).
 - C. Applicant will discuss charitable or mentorship work. How do you apply what you have learned in the classroom AND on the battlefield you're your extra-curricular activity teammates and applying it to better society? It can be something as simple as volunteer coaching a recreation league team or participating in town clean ups (90 seconds).
- **Parent Video (CONFIDENTIAL)** – Not to be released without the written or video authorization by the applicant. Please explain what happened to your parent and how it has affected you and your future (5 minutes).
- **Why should you become a Battlefield Commander?**
 - A. What do you want to do? What school will you attend? How is the scholarship and mentorship going to be applied? (5 minutes).

2 – Birth and adoptive parents are eligible.

3 – Service must be conducted in the United States and includes: Military, Law Enforcement, Emergency Responders, Corrections Officers, Federal Bureau of Investigation, United States Marshalls, United States Secret Service, United States Border Patrol

4 – Proof of employment at time of loss includes DD214, letter on company letterhead from employer, W-2 at time of loss 5 – Proof of Kinship includes Birth of Adoption Certificate.

6 – Proof of Loss includes Death Certificate

Notes to Candidates – Scholarship Application

Applications will be reviewed by the Battlefield Commander Foundation.

The scholarship is up to four years of tuition, room and board, meals, and up to ten hours per week of paid work study. Invoices and transcripts must be received directly from education provider.

Education must be for a post-high school, licensed and accredited higher education provider including, but not limited to:

- University
- College
- Technical School
- Cosmetology

Each year, the scholarship recipient must maintain a 3.2 Grade Point Average.

The Battlefield Commander Foundation reserves the right to cancel the scholarship for illegal or unethical behavior for any future semester (scholarship funds will be provided until the end of the semester in which infraction occurred).
